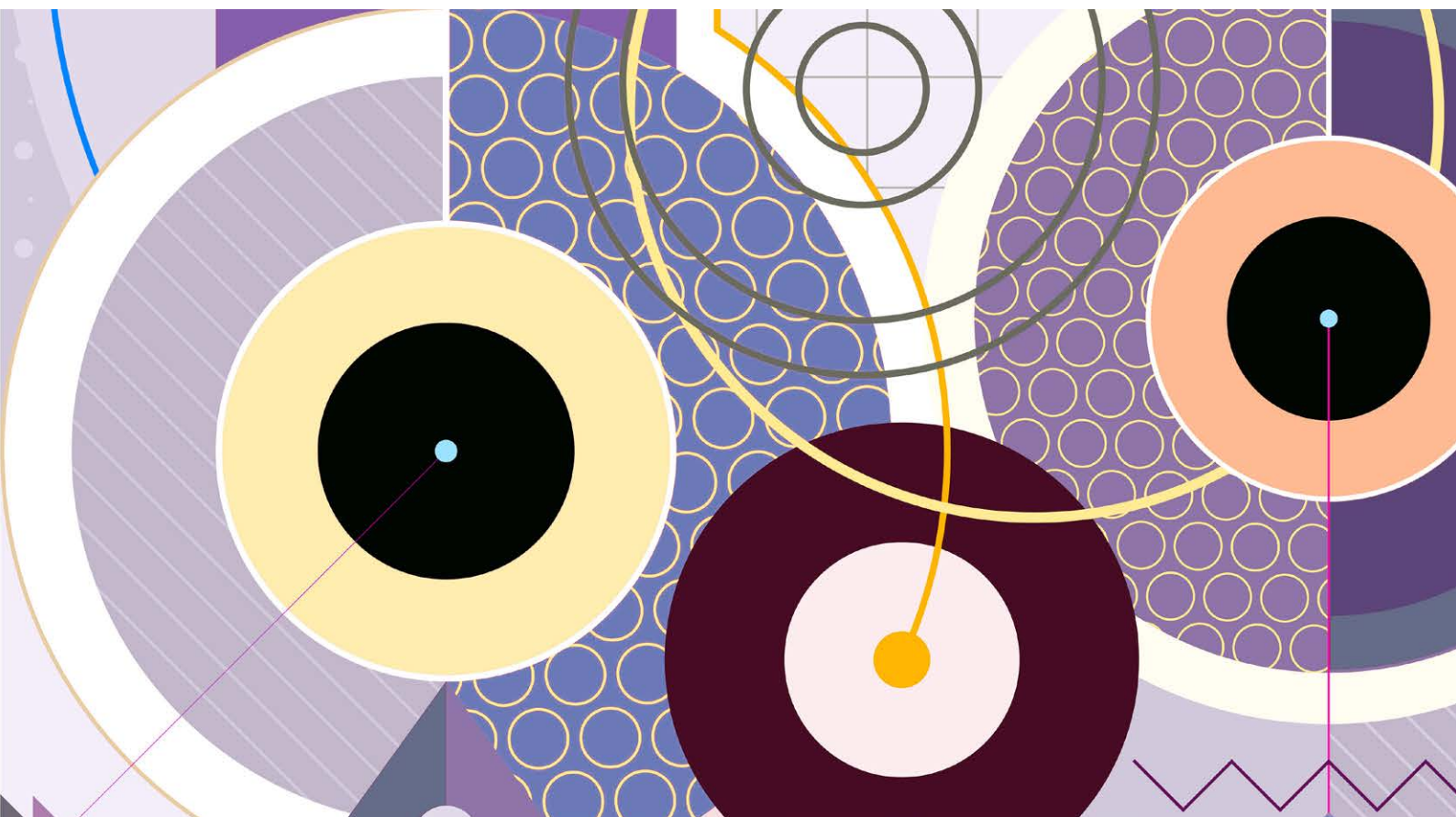


# Shared Sounds Music Teacher



# We're Hiring: Shared Sounds Music Teacher

We are looking for a committed, community-minded music teacher or facilitator to lead a series of weekly group music workshops in Flimby from Mid-October 2025 to February 2026, culminating in a live musical sharing event at the Imagine Festival in February 2026.

This project is all about learning, confidence-building, and connection through music. The sessions will offer participants the chance to develop their musical skills in a relaxed and inclusive environment – with a particular focus on piano, though we welcome artists who bring additional instruments or approaches.

The ideal artist will have experience teaching music in group settings, enjoy working with beginners and mixed-ability learners, and be excited about building a sense of community through sound.

## Project Details:

**When:** Weekly, 2-hour sessions from October 2025 to February 2026.

**Where:** Flimby (venue tbc).

**Who Attends:** Over 18's (open access group – beginners welcome).

## What's Involved:

- Group-based music teaching (especially piano).
- Fun, engaging learning environment.
- Skill development and confidence-building.
- Collaborative preparation for a live sharing event at Imagine Festival.

## What We're Offering:

- Artist Fee: circa £2,000 (based on artist fee of £45 per hour for 3 hrs per week for approx 12 weeks with additional Festival Hours to be agreed).
- Materials/Resources Budget: Available to support instruments, sheet music, teaching aids, etc.
- Planning Support: Additional time and support available for session planning and festival preparation.
- Festival Participation: Paid time to support and lead the final performance at Imagine Festival.

## We're looking for an artist who:

- Has experience teaching music in group settings.
- Can confidently teach piano (additional instruments a bonus).
- Is comfortable working with beginners and mixed-ability learners.
- Can create a welcoming, encouraging, and inclusive environment.
- Is excited to help participants prepare for a fun and celebratory live event.
- Is reliable, organised, and committed to the full project duration.
